

23.07.2010 | 10TH BOEING 747F JOINS AIRBRIDGECARGO'S FLEET

AirBridgeCargo Airlines (ABC), the scheduled cargo airline of Russia's Volga-Dnepr Group, has taken delivery of its third Boeing 747-400 freighter in four months, increasing its total fleet to 10 B747F.
